

ENGLISH 12
NICKEL & DIMED PRESENTATION

You will be responsible to teach the section of Nickel & Dimed that you have been assigned. In some cases, the section may be split up between more than one group. Your presentation must meet all of the following requirements:

- MINIMUM 5-7 minutes in length(give or take a MINUTE OR TWO)
- MAXIMUM 10 Minutes
- MUST use technology – NO POWERPOINTS/POSTER BOARDS, ETC.
 - EMAZE
 - Prezi
- Must present a “lesson plan/agenda” to Mrs. Kiel before presentation that outlines what will take place in “class” as well as a copy of all handouts that will be used and/or distributed to students. Even if you are not sure you will have enough time, make sure that everything that you would use in this lesson is included. (Better to over plan than run out of things to do during presentation.)
- Cover as much of the assigned section as possible, but focusing on the events that impact or change the course the narrator. Remember, there will be a significant amount of the class that will have not read your assigned section.
- All members **must** participate which means actively participate in the entire presentation. This includes creation and presentation.
- All members must look the part which means that you should look nice. You do not have to “dress up” if you don’t want to but as the teacher, you should not have sweats, t-shirts, etc on.
- Must contain at least 2 obviously different activities/sections.
- Within the 5-7 minutes presentation groups need to have at least **TWO** of the following:
 - *Have at least one interactive activity(students doing something)*
 - *Have at least one writing activity (vocabulary, entrance/exit slip, journal, response, etc)*
 - *Have at least one activity where students are reading.*
 - *Have at least one visual aid(film clip, chart for students, map, etc)*
 - *Film clips can be no more than a 1-1.5 minutes)*
 - *Have at least one additional source, besides novel (film, article, etc.) that is included in the 5-7 minute presentation.*
 - *Have at least one handout for students(summary, worksheet, chart, diagram, etc)*

The rest is up to you and your group, just make sure that ALL aspects of the project are covered because if one of your members is absent on the day you are scheduled to present, you MUST go on without them.

Do not hesitate to ask questions or discuss ideas with Mrs. Kiel.
