1. What does Rev Parris question his niece Abigail about?
2. What is Parris' main concern?
3. What does Betty Parris reveal about what happened in the woods?
4. What has happened in the past between John Proctor and Abigail? How do each of them feel about it now?

### **Act Two**

5. Why did Mary Warren disobey her employers and gone to Salem?
6. Why hasn't John told the court what he knows? What does Elizabeth attribute his not telling to?
7. Why does Reverend Hale visit the Proctors?
8. Discuss the meaning of the quote, "Adultery, John" (pg67)
9. What does Herrick and Cheever find as evidence in the Proctor household?
10. Who brought it there?
11. Who is accusing Elizabeth of witchery?

### **Act Three**

12. When John Proctor arrives at court with Marry Warren, what does Reverend Parris accuse him of?
13. What does "Do that which is good, and no harm shall com to thee" mean? Who says it? Who are they saying it to /about? (pg 95)
14. What is Reverend Hale's advice to John Proctor as he is about to read his disposition before the court?
15. When Mary Warren says that she pretended to fain in court, what is she asked to do? What is the result?
16. Who is called to back up John's testimony? What happens?
17. What happens when Reverend Hale states that Abigail has always seemed false to him?
18. What is Mary's reaction to Abigail's performance?
19. What does John Proctor mean when he says, "God is dead!"?
20. What does Hale do when Proctor is arrested?

**Summarize Act III**-10 pts- be thorough in your response, "people were accused of being witches in court and got prosecuted" doesn't cut it. Use names, be specific and give examples or quotes in your response.
